Introduction

CODE V and LightTools software and license keys are available for download from the Synopsys SolvNet website. This document provides instructions on how CODE V and LightTools users can obtain the software and license keys. See **Definitions** on page 12 if any terminology is unfamiliar to you.

Signing Up for a SolvNet Account

All users who download CODE V and LightTools software and license keys must sign up for a Synopsys SolvNet Account.

1. Go to <https://solvnet.synopsys.com> and click the **Sign Up For An Account** link.

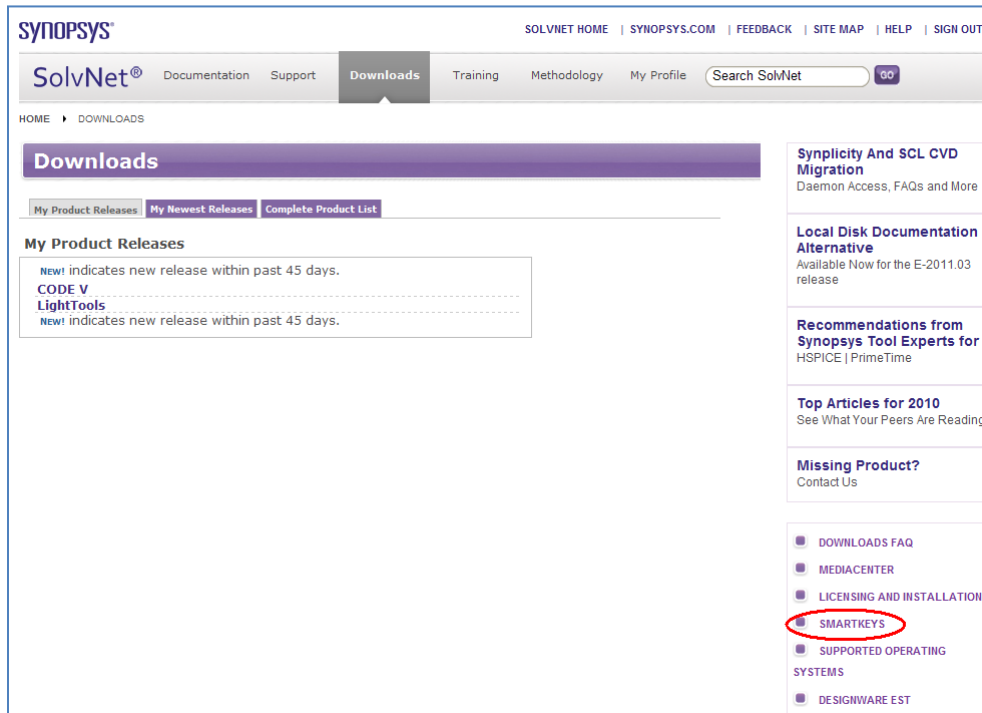


2. During the registration process, you will need to enter your company's Site ID. If you do not know your company's Site ID, please contact solvnetfeedback@synopsys.com to request it. Be sure to include your company name and address in the email request.
3. SolvNet will send you a confirmation email. Follow the link in the email to complete the registration process.

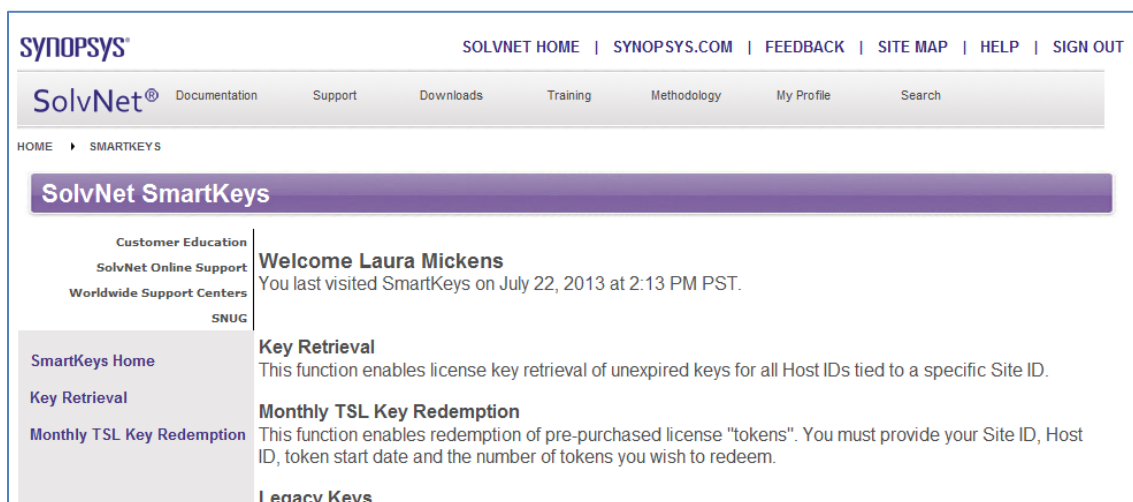
Obtaining License Keys

A License Key is a file containing licensing information for your specific USB dongle (or PC Hardware if no dongle is used). The SmartKeys web interface on the Synopsys SolvNet site can be used to obtain license keys. To obtain your license keys:

1. Navigate to the SmartKeys page on SolvNet. You can go to SmartKeys directly using this link: <https://solvnet.synopsys.com/SmartKeys>. You can also navigate there from the SolvNet Downloads page by clicking the **SmartKeys** link in the lower right column.



2. On the SolvNet SmartKeys home page, click the **Key Retrieval** link.



3. The SmartKeys Key Retrieval page displays. Click the **Retrieve Licenses** button to receive an email with the license keys for your company.



Note: You will receive separate emails for each Host ID at your company, each with a single license key attached. This will include license keys for *all Synopsys products* that your company licenses. To obtain license keys for a single USB dongle, you can enter the Host ID of your CODE V or LightTools USB dongle in the **Host ID (Optional)** data field. If you do not know the Host ID value for your USB dongle, see Obtaining Host IDs on page 5.

License Key Delivery

Your CODE V or LightTools license key will be delivered as a text file attached to an email from the SmartKeys system. The email will include the Host ID for which the license key is valid. Below is a sample License Key email. Save this file to a convenient location on your PC. You will need to access this file to activate CODE V or LightTools.

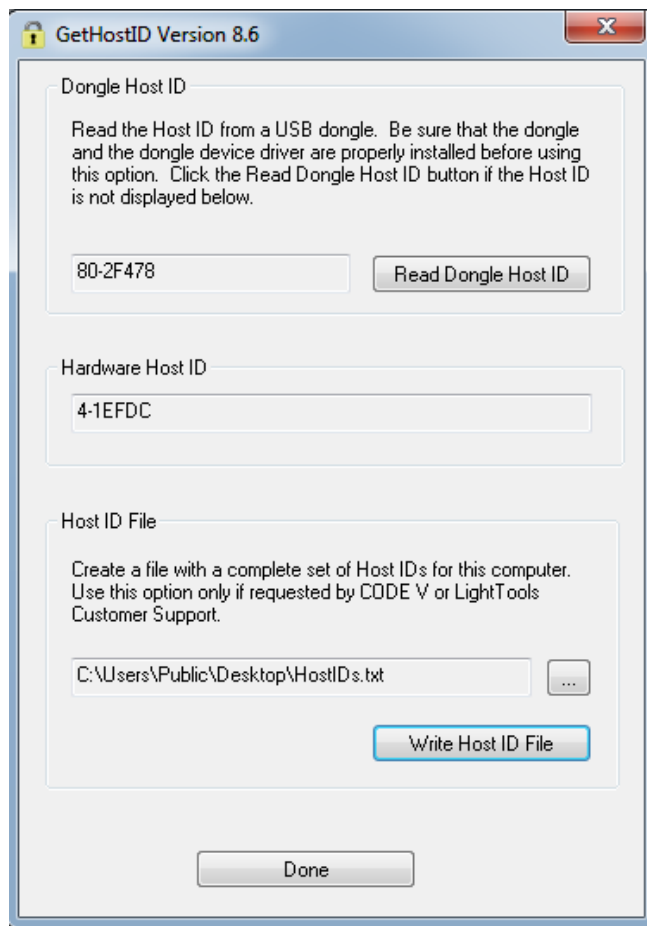

Obtaining Host IDs

The Host ID is a unique value encoded on the USB dongle (or PC hardware if you are not using a dongle) used to run CODE V or LightTools. Each license key is associated with a specific Host ID. If you have multiple seats of CODE V and/or LightTools at your company, you can identify which license key file is associated with your specific USB dongle using the Host ID value.

If you do not know the Host ID value for your USB dongle, you can download a copy of the GetHostID utility from <http://optics.synopsys.com/support/support-host-id.html>.

Double-click the file GetHostID.exe to launch the utility.

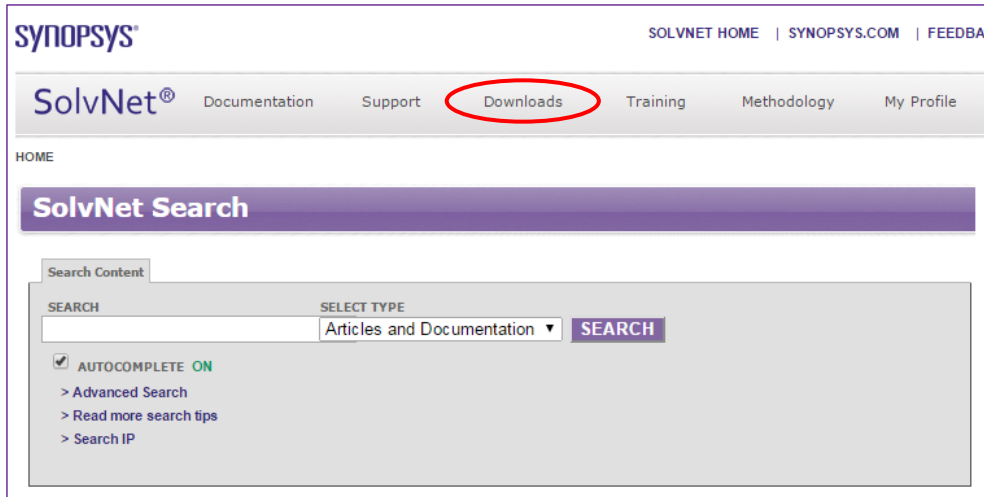


In the above example, the Host ID for the USB dongle is 80-2F478. If the GetHostID utility is encountering problems reading the USB dongle, you may need to download and install the Sentinel USB Key driver from <http://optics.synopsys.com/support/support-usb-drivers.html>.

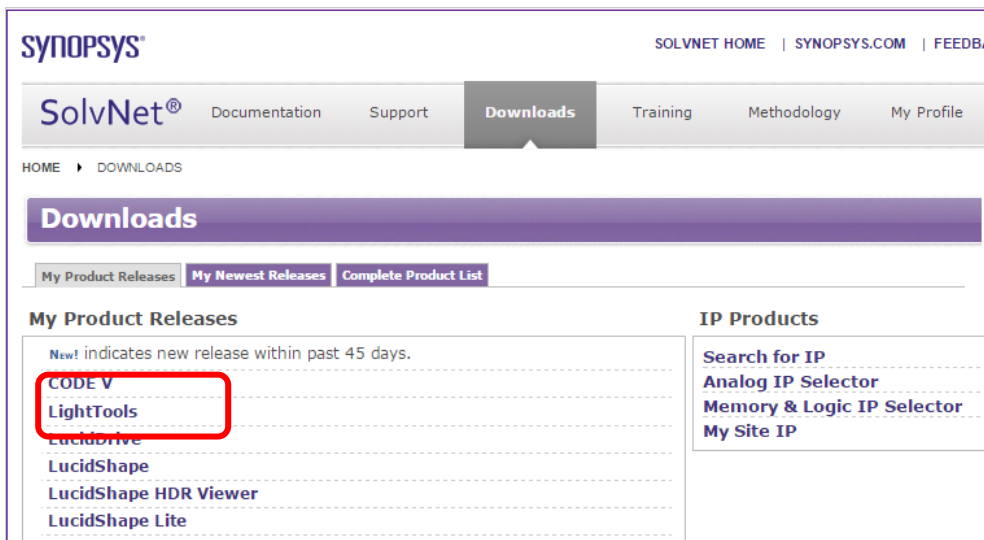
If you are not using a USB dongle, your license key is associated with a unique Host ID value for your specific PC hardware. In the above example, the Host ID for the PC hardware is 4-1EFDC.

Downloading CODE V or LightTools from SolvNet

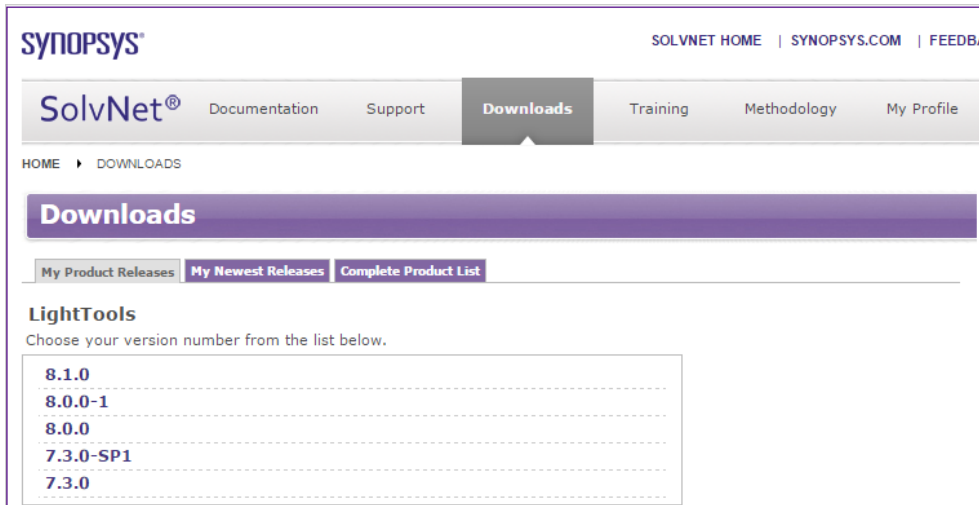
1. To download CODE V or LightTools software, log onto your SolvNet account and click **Downloads**.



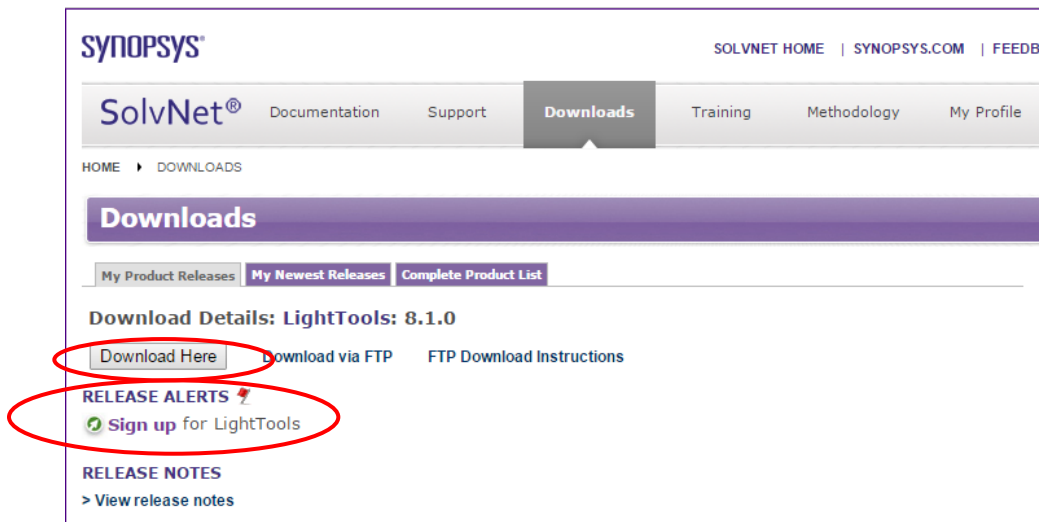
2. You can also use this direct link: <https://solvnet.synopsys.com/DownloadCenter>.
3. Select the product you want to download. All Synopsys products currently licensed at your company will be listed. The following example shows only CODE V and LightTools.



4. Select the specific version you would like to download.

5. Click the **Release Alerts** link to display a **Release Alerts** pop-up page that allows you to subscribe to Release Notification emails from SolvNet. These emails let you know when a new version of CODE V or LightTools is available for download.

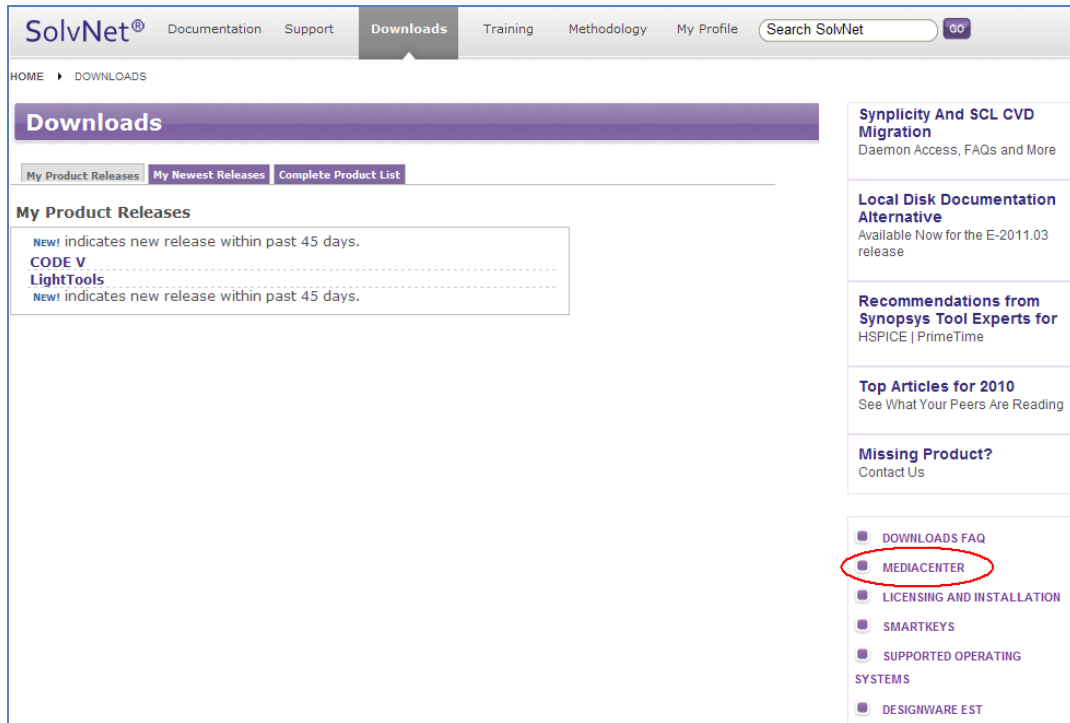

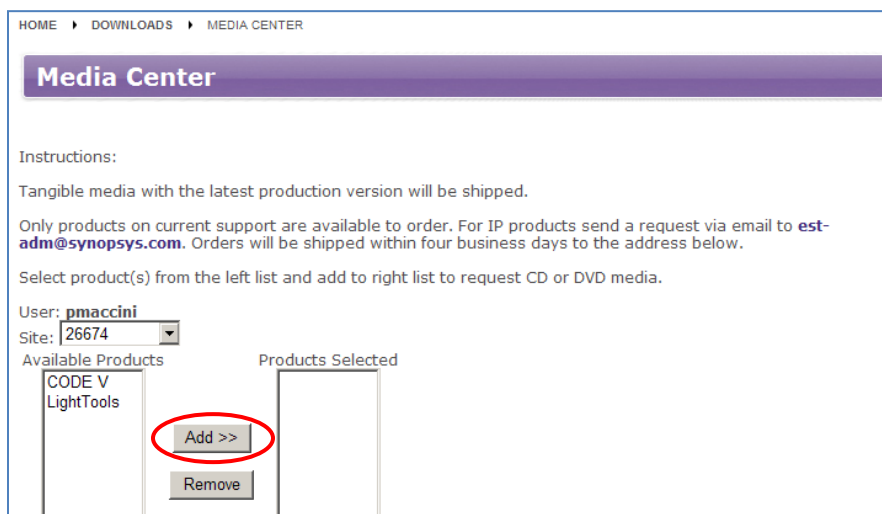
Ordering Media (CDs/DVDs)

Installing CODE V or LightTools

Complete installation instructions for both CODE V and LightTools are available at <http://optics.synopsys.com/support/support-install-lic-overview.html>. Following is a high-level overview.

Fixed License Users

1. Install CODE V or LightTools on your PC. After downloading the latest CODE V or LightTools release from SolvNet, double-click the downloaded .exe file to start the installation. You will need administrator privileges on your PC to complete the installation process.
2. After installing CODE V or LightTools, you will need to obtain your license key. After receiving your license key file from SmartKeys, save it to a convenient location on your PC.
3. To apply the license key file, choose:
Start > Programs > CODE V 10.x > Fixed License Installer
or:
Start > Programs > LightTools 8.x.x > Fixed License Installer
Browse to your license key file and select it.

Floating License Users

If you use CODE V or LightTools with a floating license, the Sentinel License Manager must be installed on the network server. The Sentinel License Manager is also available for download at <http://optics.synopsys.com/support/support-install-lic-overview.html>.

Definitions

Below is a summary of terms used in this document.

SolvNet: The Synopsys customer portal (<https://solvnet.synopsys.com>). This is where you will go to download CODE V and LightTools, as well as the license keys.

SmartKeys: SolvNet page where license key requests are made.

License Key: License file containing the encoded information needed to run CODE V or LightTools for a specific USB dongle or PC.

Host ID: Hexadecimal value (for example, 80-1A23D) encoded on the USB dongle or specific PC. The Synopsys SmartKeys site and delivery email reference the Host ID value when license keys are requested and delivered.

Site ID: Unique number used to identify a specific company. Every company that uses CODE V and LightTools software, or other Synopsys software, will have a unique site ID.
